

The deed between [Norborne ?] G. Gray and his wife Ella Gray George Taylor and his wife Anna M. Taylor [illegible] G [Heurant?] and Catherine Fetter parties of the first part and the Bishop of Kentucky of the second part.

Witnesseth that in consideration of One Dollar cash in hand paid and in further consideration with the property herein conveyed in to be used in connection with the property heretofore conveyed to the party of the second part by the heir of John Thomas Gray Sr. for a Mission under the control of the Christ Church Cathedral, Louisville Kentucky until such mission has been organized as an Independent parish of the Protestant Episcopal Church of the Diocese of Kentucky and thereafter to be used for the benefit of such new Parish and not otherwise the parties of the first part do hereby convey to the party of the second part in fee simple, the following described lot or parcel of land with its appertances and improvements in Louisville Jefferson County Kentucky namely:

A certain lot or parcel of land beginning at a point the West line of Floyd Street One hundred and twenty nine feet and six inches, North of the North line of Ormsby Avenue coming thence Northwardly with the North line of Floyd Street One hundred and five feet thence westwardly forty five feet to the north east corner of the church property, thence southwardly one hundred and five feet to the Southeast corner of the Church property thence Eastwardly Forty-five feet to the point of beginning.

Another certain lot or parcel of land beginning on a point One Hundred and twenty nine feet And six inches North after North line of Ormsby Avenue in the East line of the first alley West of Floyd Street, on the North side of Ormsby Avenue, thence North with the East line of said alley One Hundred and five feet thence Eastwardly Twenty feet to the Northwest corner of the Church property thence Southwardly One Hundred and five feet to the Southwest corner of the Church property thence Westwardly Seventy feet to the point of beginning. Being the same property conveyed to the said first parties by deed Book 464 Page 114.
