

This Deed from George E. H. Gray and Lucy A. Gray his wife Elizabeth M Galt Jno F. Gray and Caroline Gray his wife Henry W Gray and Mary E Gray his wife George G Fetter and Catherine A Fetter his wife Ormsby Gray Job Reamer and Lizzie L his wife Elias Lawrence and Ben H Lawrence who include all the heirs of John T. Gray died grantors to the Rt. Rev. T. U. Dudley Bishop of Kentucky and his successors in office trustees as is hereafter expressed grantes. Witnesseth that for and in consideration of two dollars in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged and of the [illegible] hereinafter mentioned the grantors have bargained and sold and by thier presents do grant and convey to the grantee the lot of ground 105 feet square part of out lot as 29 on the plat of Arthur S Campbell Exor of Arthur Campell decd. It being the lot reserved for a burying place in the conveyance of said out lot No 29 made by John F. Gray and his wife and Levi Tyler to J. B. Bland dated the 24th day of February 1831 and recorded in the Jefferson Court Clerks office in Deed Book EE page 223 to which reference is hereby made for a fuller description. It having been so laid off as to include in its north east corner the graves which existed at the date of the said conveyance on the said out lot No 29 and now exist.

To have and to hold the said one hundred and five feet square to the said grantes and his heirs forever with all rights priveleges and appurtenances thereunto belonging or appertaining in trust for the use and benefit of the Protestant Episcopal Church of the Diocese of Kentucky to be used only for some religious or charitable purpose with out removing or disturbing said graves.
